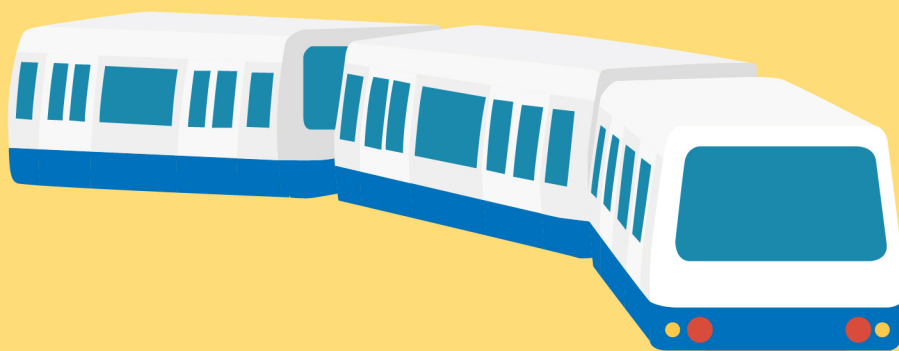


The MRT Takes You to Visit Taipei

if you'd like to have some fun?**



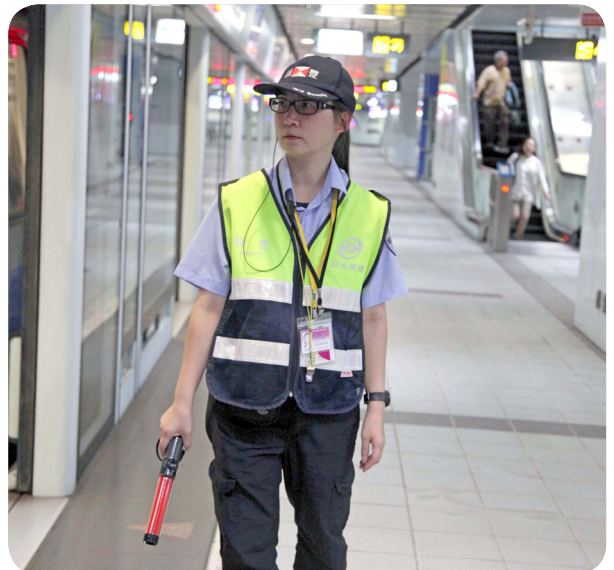
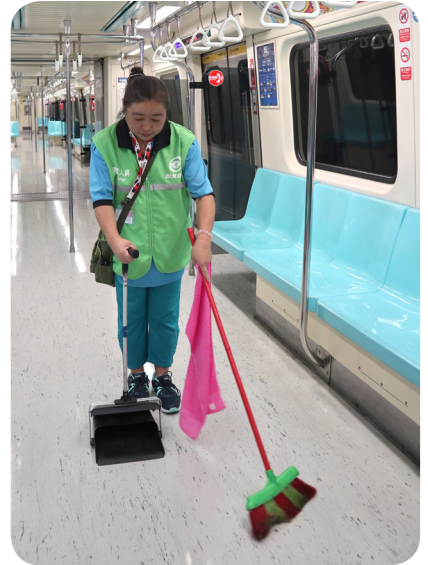


Who can help you in a MRT station?



If you have any questions,
you can go to the information center.
The staff there can help you.

If you are not sure about your direction,
or you have problems finding the right exit,
look for the staff in vests,
they would be happy to help you.

Beitou Park Outdoor Hot Spring



A lot of people like to soak in the **hot spring** here.
You only need to pay 40 dollars to enjoy the hot spring.



You can also soak your feet.
Go to **Fuxing Park Foot Bath Area**.
You can give it a try!



After enjoying the hot spring,
you can visit **Beitou Hot Spring Museum**.

Some exhibitions are held here.

Long time ago,
the 1st floor used to house the biggest hot spring bath in Taiwan.

Thermal Valley is also famous in Beitou.

Look at the white smoke in the springs!

Now you are stepping in a fairy's land.



How do you get to Beitou Park Outdoor Hot Spring?

Take the red line to MRT **R22 Beitou** station.

Transfer to MRT **R22A Xinbeitou** station.

Walk for 7 minutes.

The museum and Thermal Valley are not far from the MRT station.

You can ask the information center for the right direction.



Taipei Children's Amusement Park



Do you see the big white roof in the picture?
This is **Taipei Children's Amusement Park**.



There is a **theater** inside the park.
You can watch the show.
There are a lot of interesting programs.



You can play **chairoplane**.

You can also ride on a **Ferris wheel**,
and many other interesting recreational facilities!

If you feel hungry, go to the **Shilin Night Market**!
There are a lot of yummy food there,
and also beautiful clothes, shoes, and toys!



How do you get to Taipei Children's Amusement Park?

Take the red line to MRT **R16 Shilin** station.

Take Exit 1 and walk for 20 minutes.

Or you can take the bus,
such as 620, Red 30, or Taipei Children's Amusement Park 1.



How do you get to Shilin Night Market?

Take the red line to MRT **R15 Jiantan** station.

Take Exit 1 and walk for 6 minutes.

You can ask the information center for the right direction.



Ningxia Night Market



You cannot smoke in **Ningxia Night Market**.
And the cars are not allowed here either.



A lot of **yummy food and drinks** are waiting for you here.
You can also play balloon shooting, and pinball machine.
Maybe you can even win some trophies!



How do you get to Ningxia Night Market?

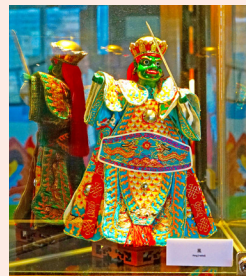
You could take the red line to MRT **R12 Shuanglian** station .
Take Exit 1 and walk for 9 minutes.



The night market is not opened yet during the daytime hours.
 You can go to **Dadaocheng Theater**.
 There are exhibitions of **traditional palmar-drama**.
 You can also buy a ticket to **watch a traditional opera**.

How do you get to Dadaocheng Theater?

Take the green line to MRT **G13 Beimen** station.
 Take Exit 2 or Exit 3 and walk for 8 minutes.



Taipei 101



Taipei 101 is the tallest building in Taiwan.

Right by the side of Taipei 101,
look around you,
see if you could find the **red "Love"** in the picture,
a lot of people take a picture here.



If you are visiting Taipei 101,
buy a ticket at the 5th floor,
take the elevator to the deck at **the 89th floor**,
now the whole city is right beneath your feet!



On the evening of every December 31st,
Taipei 101 is also a wonderful place for people to get together,
"5, 4, 3, 2, 1, Happy New Year!"
After hearing this,
you can see the beautiful fireworks!

How do you get to Taipei 101?

You can take the red line to
MRT **R03 Taipei 101/ World Trade Center** station.
Take Exit 4.



Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall



Many people enjoy exercising or dancing here.



Do you see two grand houses with exactly the same look?
They are **National Theater Hall** and **National Concert Hall**.
You can buy a ticket and go inside to watch a show.



You can also see **the changing of the guards** every hour on the hour!

The guard of honor is a very special army.

The place allotted with the guard of honor is an important place.

You can tell they belong to the Army, the Navy, or Air Force by the color of their uniform.

"Every hour on the hour" means:

9am, 10am, 11am, 12pm, 1pm, 2pm, 3pm, 4pm, and 5pm.

How do you get to Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall?

Take the green line or the red line to MRT **G10/R08 Chiang Kai-Shek Memorial Hall** station. Take Exit 5.



Dadaocheng Wharf



Dadaocheng Wharf is right beside the **Tamsui River**.
Long time ago, many people sold their things here by boat.



Now you can take a ferry here.
Enjoy the beautiful scenery.



You can also find **Taipei Xia-Hai City God Temple** on **Dihua Street**.

The Matchmaking God is famous here.

He is the god of love and marriage.

A lot of people believe in his power to help people to get married.



How do you get to Dadaocheng Wharf?

Take the green line to MRT **G13 Beimen** station.

Take Exit 3 and walk for 15 minutes.



How do you get to Taipei Xia-Hai City God Temple?

Starting to walk from MRT **G13 Beimen** station,
Exit 3 for 8 minutes.

Ask the information center for your direction.



Bangka Longshan Temple



This temple was built in 1738.



Lots of people pray here.

They ask for the gods for help.

Remember to step inside from the right side of the temple.

Raise your leg high, and don't step on the threshold.

The temple is covered with beautiful carvings.

Look around you:

Where are these carvings?



The Herb Lane is beside Bangka Longshan Temple.
Have a cup of cold **Chinese herbal tea** there.

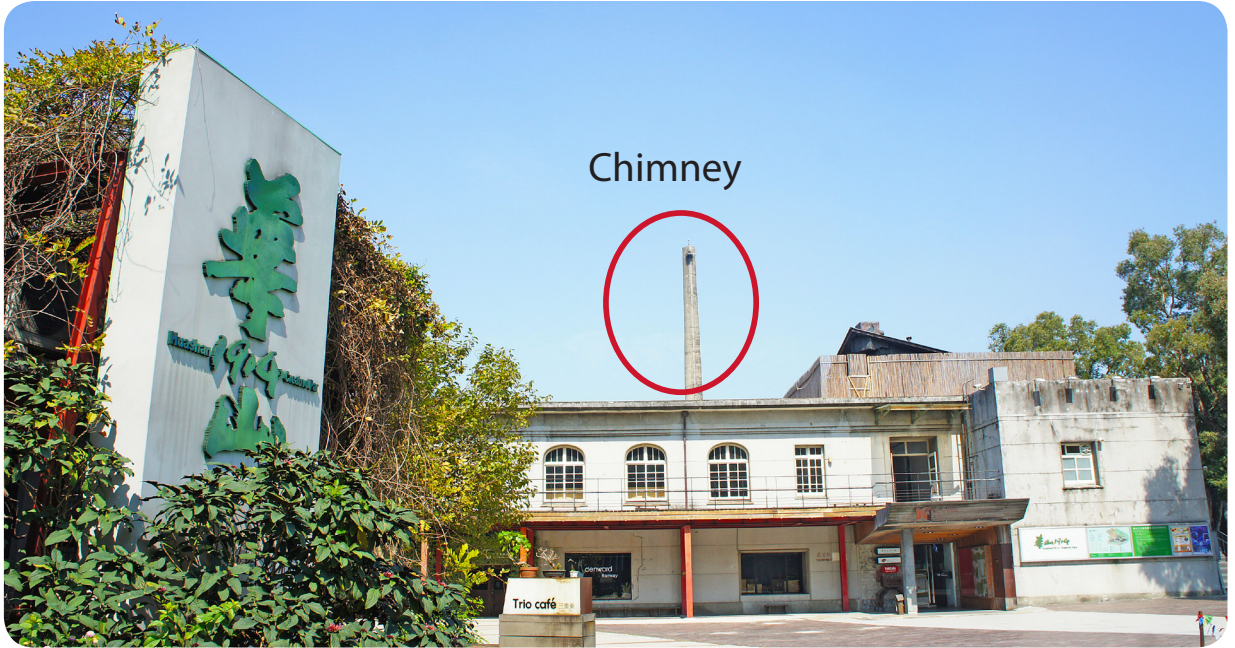


How do you get to Bangka Longshan Temple?

Take the blue line to MRT **BL10 Longshan Temple** station.
Take Exit 1 and walk for 3 minutes.



Huashan 1914 Creative Park



Do you see the high chimney?

In 1914, people made wine here.

Now it has become a space for exhibiting art and culture.



There are four adjoining houses in the Creative Park.
Exhibitions with bigger scale will be held here.

There are many special shops here.
The shops sell special and beautiful products here.
One of the shops sells a lot of pretty music boxes and wooden toys.
You can buy a ticket to give it a try.



How do you get to Huashan 1914 Creative Park?

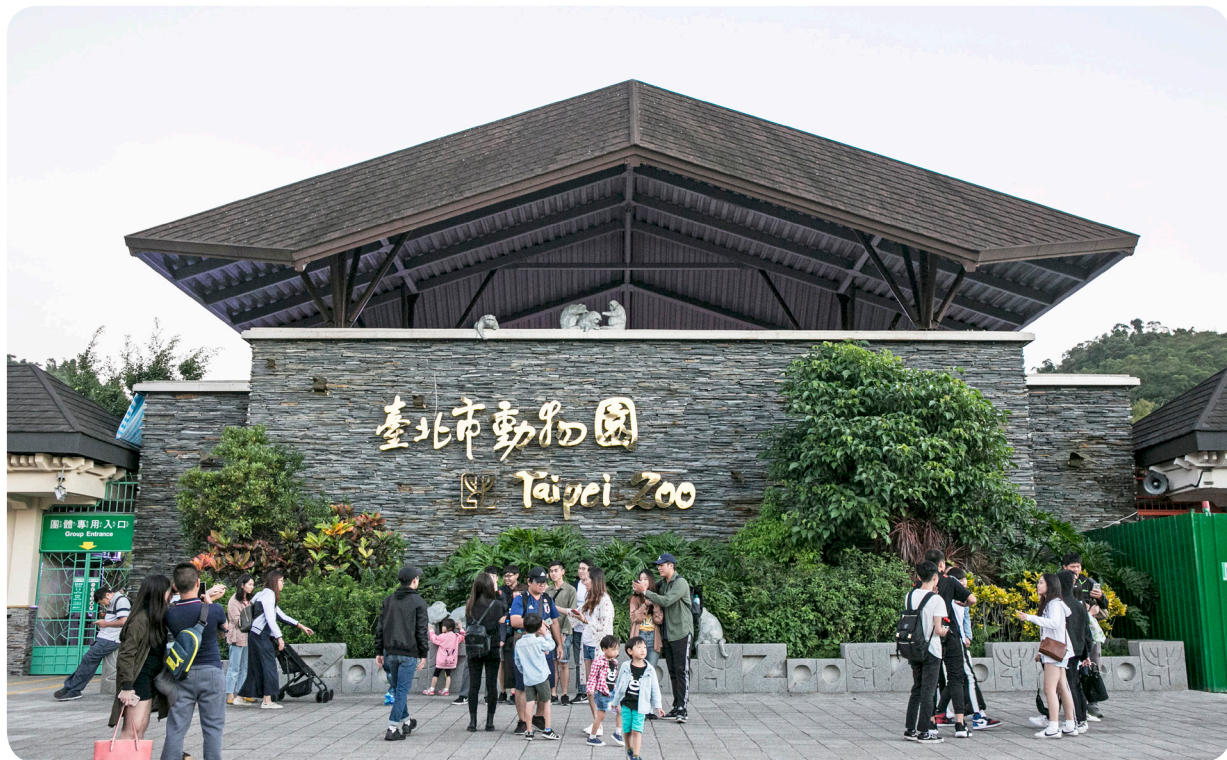
Take the blue line or the orange line to
MRT BL14/ O07 Zhongxiao Xincheng station.

Take Exit 1 and walk for 3 minutes.

You can ask the information center for the right direction.

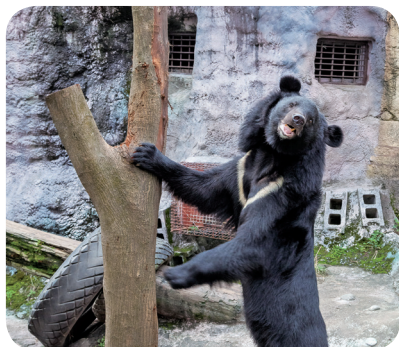


Taipei Zoo

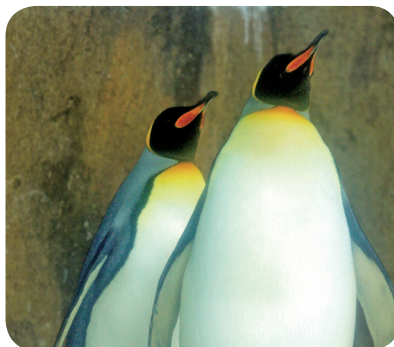


Come visit the **Taipei Zoo!**

How do you get to the Taipei Zoo?

Take the brown line to MRT **BR01 Taipei Zoo** station.
Take Exit 1 and walk for 5 minutes.



Taipei Songshan Airport Observation Deck



If you want to see **airplanes**, this is the right place!
You will find some planes that are not taking off yet.
The planes need to prepare for their next flight.



You can also find various plane models here.



There are cute cats on the wall beside.
Go take a picture!



People go to **Taipei Songshan Airport** to take a plane.
You will meet lots of tourists, flight attendants, and pilots there.
They are probably ready to go abroad,
or they are just getting off the plane to Taiwan.

If you have the chance to take a plane,
don't forget to tell foreign friends that Taipei is wonderful!



How do you get to **Taipei Songshan Airport Observation Deck?**

Take the brown line to MRT **BR13 Songshan Airport** station.
Take Exit 2 and walk to **Terminal 2 (domestic line)**.
Go into the Terminal 2 by column 18,
and you'll find the observation deck in the 3rd floor.
If you're not sure about your direction,
go ask the Terminal staff for help.
